“Bridging Over” to Boy Scouts

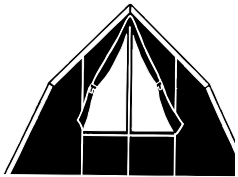

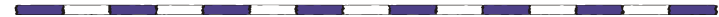
Spring Family Campout
