This patch came about after learning that less than 3% of Scouts earn their religious emblem in any given year. We want to put the focus back on *Duty to God* and encourage Scouts to earn the religious emblem for their faith.

The requirements are simple: attend or make a presentation on religious emblems, and make a commitment to *Duty to God*.

We encourage you to make a presentation on the religious emblems to your unit and present your Scouts with this new patch. You can find a video, sample scripts, and slide presentations on our web site. We also offer these resources on DVD. **For a limited time, anybody who purchases 10 patches will receive a FREE DVD.** Patches may be pre-ordered so that you can distribute them at the conclusion of your presentation. Please note that P.R.A.Y. offers price breaks on larger quantities.

If your young people have recently earned their religious emblems, they would automatically qualify for the first year segment. The patch is a four-segment puzzle patch to encourage leaders to make presentations every year.
