- **Next Pack Meeting-** December 15<sup>th</sup>. Set up/snack- Lodes, Flags- Kruse, Skit- Beeler, Run on- Palmer. We will be having snow shoe races, so don't forget to make them.

**Popcorn Sales:** Council has set \$10,300 as our Pack goal this year.

- The Committee voted to offer \$5.00 in Cub Bucks for the highest selling den and highest average selling Scout on a weekly basis as an incentive to meet our goal. The boys will report their sales to their den leader each Monday evening and the leaders will report these numbers to Marc on Tuesday morning. If boys do not report weekly sales to Den Leader on time then they will not be eligible that week for the Cub Bucks.
- Everyone will receive a patch; the top sellers will receive a patch and a flag for their den in addition to the prizes offered by Council and the Pack.
- The Committee voted to award a \$10 Toys R Us gift certificate for the top five overall sellers (including ties).
- ALL scouts will put their name on each check so any insufficient funds checks can be returned to them for possible collection of funds. Money can be collected up front this year

Summer Camp Details-

Webelos Camp: 6 days, 5 nights; cost = \$150 per scout

Webelos Mini-Camp: 3 days, 2 nights; cost = \$80 per scout

Dad-n-Lad & Mom-n-Me: 2 days, 1 night; cost = \$27 **per person** For the Webelos & Webelos Mini-Camp, we will be allowed one free leader per ten boys (i.e., 1 free leader for 3-10 boys, 2 free leaders for 11-20 boys, etc.). Any additional leaders/parents who desire to attend will cost \$50 each for Webelos camp & \$30 each for Webelos mini-camp. I informed the parents that if they think their child would like to attend, then, they should reserve a spot and pay the \$25 registration fee by this upcoming pack meeting. If they decide later (before April 15) that they would not like to attend, then they can get a **full refund**. Therefore, if any of your parents/scouts think they will be interested in attending, they should go ahead and sign up and pay the registration fee so that we can get in the lottery session and get our preferred dates the camps. Because of our guys' school schedule, we will be restricted to certain camp dates, as the other dates will begin after the new school year starts. Finalize, please note the costs for the Dad-n-Lad/Mom-n-Me, as parents will pay the same cost as the scouts.
