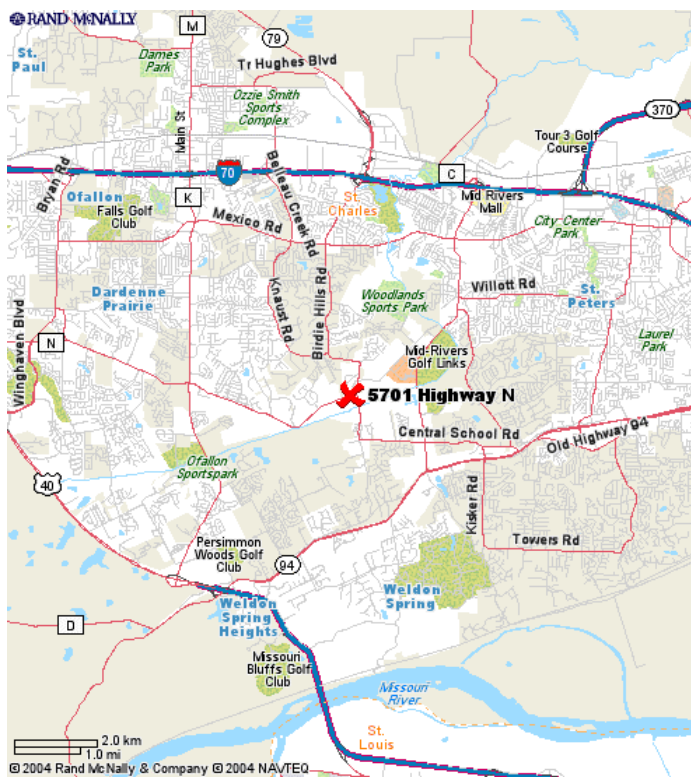

From O'Fallon, take Highway K south, then left on Highway N.

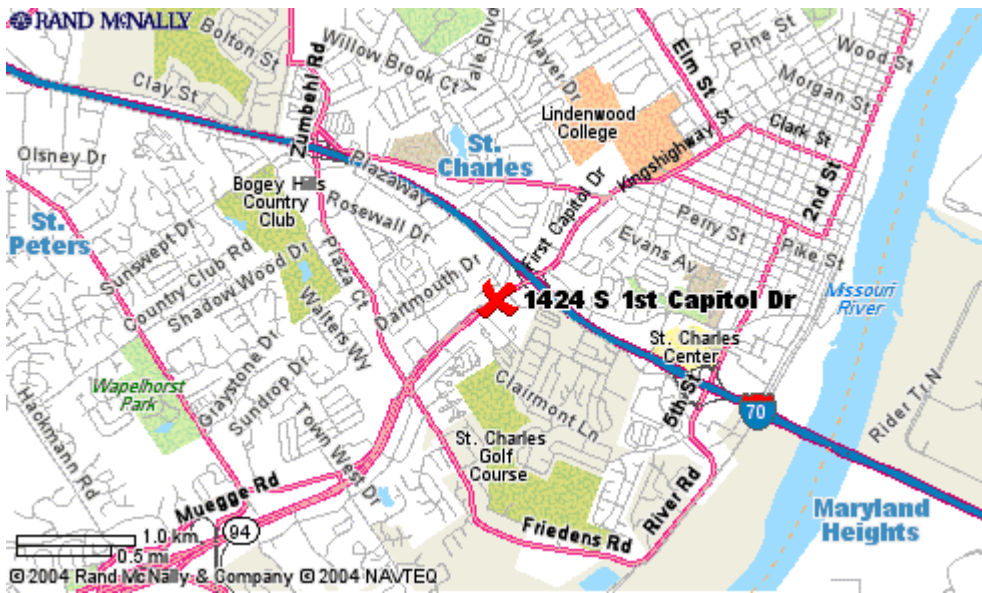
From St Peters, take Mid-Rivers Mall Dr south, then right on Highway N.

From St Charles, take Highway 94 south, then right on Mid-Rivers Mall Drive and then left on Highway N.

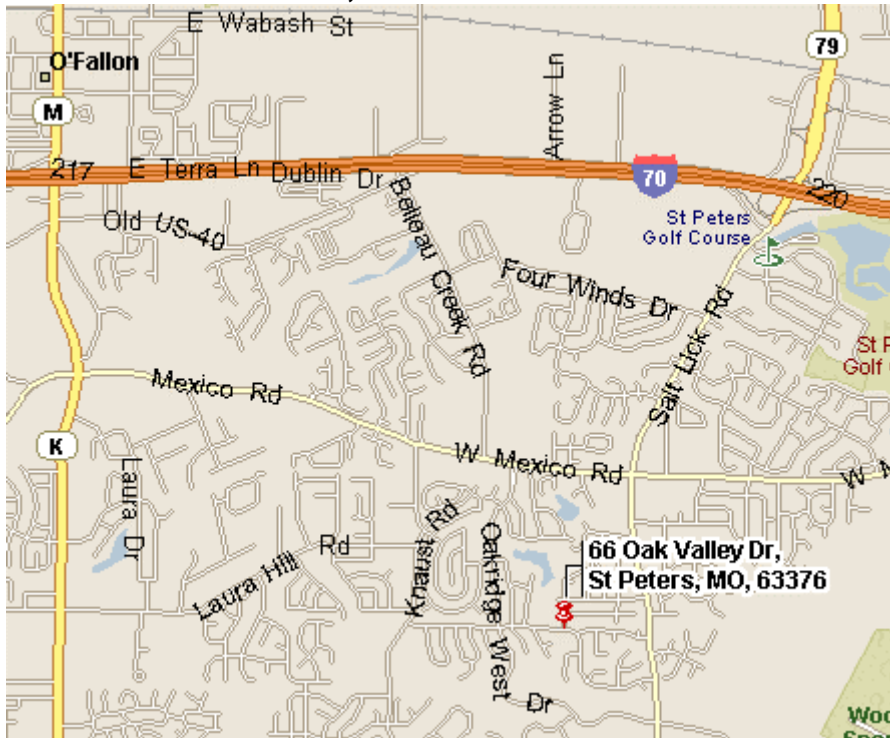
From Highway 40 and Highway 94, take Highway 94 north, left on Mid-Rivers Mall Drive and then left on Highway N.

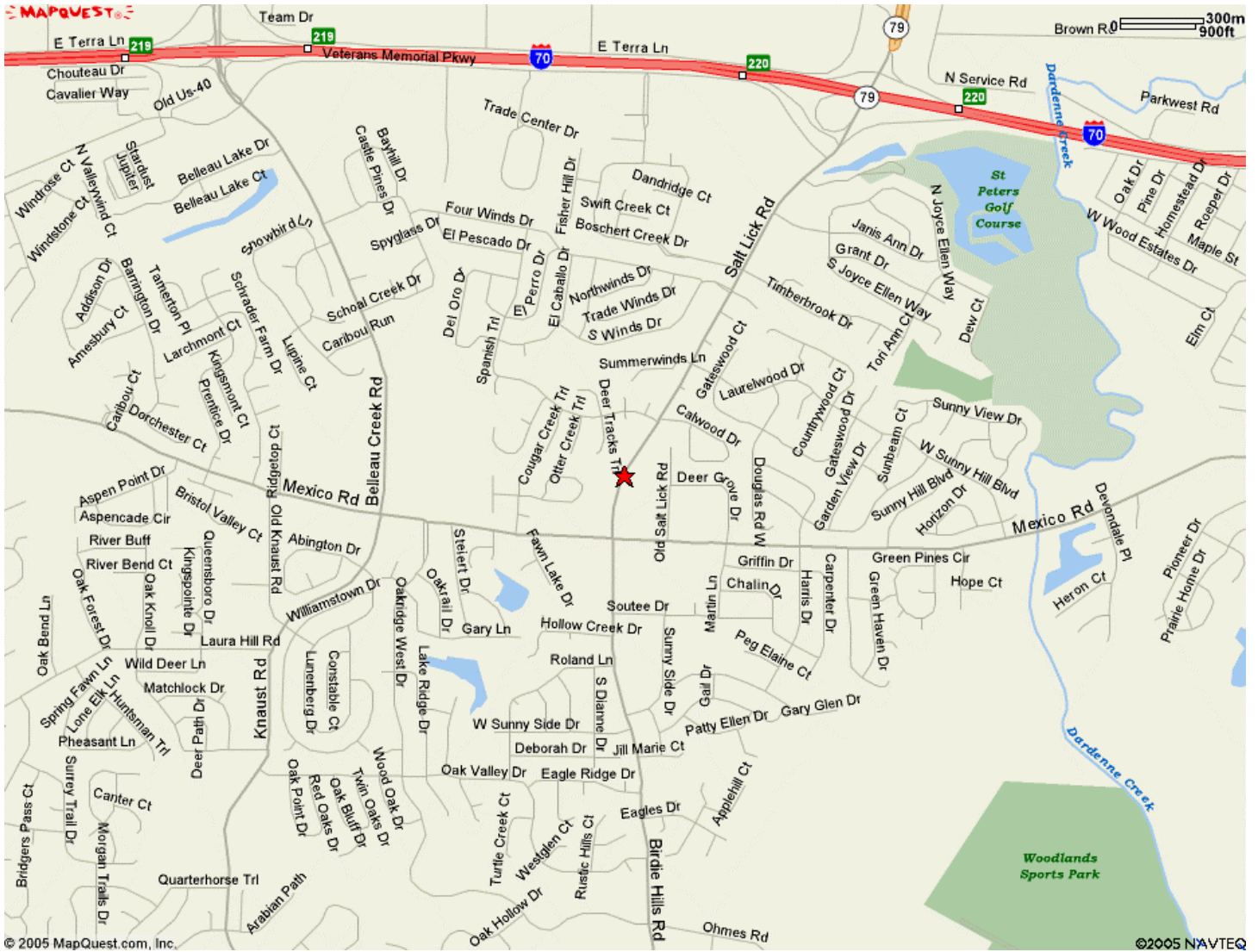
Knights of Columbus Hall is located west of Cottleville on Highway N, approximately ¼ mile west of Wiese Road. Look for the sign.
